Parents should register for the Baptism Preparation Program at the rectory...even before the baby is born!



**Request for Papal Blessings**

If you have a special event coming up in your own life or in the life of your family, e.g., wedding, 25<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary, special birthday, you may want to request a Papal Blessing to mark the occasion. The blessings can come from either the Vatican itself or the Vatican Embassy in Washington, D.C.

***Please note the following guidelines:***

- 1) The individuals named in the blessing must be practicing Catholics.
  - 2) Only one blessing can be obtained per person.
  - 3) If requested from the Vatican, the blessing should be requested 4 months in advance of the occasion. The cost is \$45.00.
  - 4) If requested from the Vatican Embassy in Washington, D.C., the blessing should be requested 2 months in advance. The cost is \$30.00.
- 5) These requests have to be made through the St. Mary's office. ***Please plan ahead if you want to request a Papal Blessing.***

**Boy Scout Eagle Project**

I am Dylan Courtney and a Boy Scout out of Dumont's Troop 64. For my Eagle Project, I am revamping the Life File System. The Life File System has been revamped with a simple medical form, a new sticker, and a new design for the magnetic holder. This program alerts Dumont's emergency medical responders, via a decal placed on your front door, that a patient's medical history is accessible in a magnetic pouch placed on the refrigerator door to facilitate rapid pre-hospital care. This is also important for patients that may be incapacitated and cannot convey information that is pertinent or critical to their treatment. Thanks to the Konze Foundation, the Dumont Volunteer Ambulance Corp., and Keystone Printing we are able to renew this program to benefit Dumont Residents.

For the **first stage** of the project, my volunteers handed out a door hanger asking you to participate in the program, with a postcard on the bottom. If you did not receive a door hanger, extras are at the Dumont Public Library for pick up. I am asking Dumont Residents to either mail back the postcard to the Dumont Volunteer Ambulance Corp. or drop it off at the Dumont Volunteer Ambulance Corp. on 108 Brook Street by **July 15<sup>th</sup>**.






# Life File System



In 2005, The Philip and Louise Konze Charitable Foundation funded the Dumont Volunteer Ambulance Corps' first 'LifeFile' outreach. It is a program that alerts Dumont's emergency medical responders, via a decal placed on your front door, that a patient's medical history is accessible in a magnetic pouch placed on the refrigerator door to facilitate rapid pre-hospital care.
