Parents should register for the Baptism Preparation Program at the rectory...even before the baby is born!

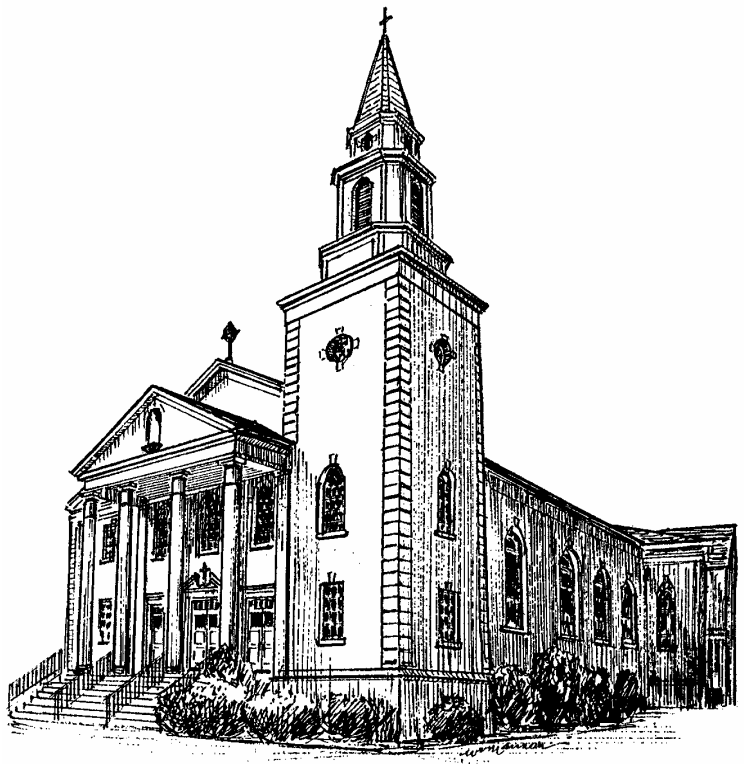
