

Ministry to the Sick and Homebound The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is available to be celebrated with anyone in need. Please do not wait until death is imminent to contact the parish regarding an ill family member. Eucharistic Ministers and others serve our community by visiting and bringing Communion to the sick and homebound. Please call the parish office if you wish such a visit.

God's Plan for Giving - Tithing Tithing is God's plan to support His Church. Full tithing means 10% of gross income to God. We ask half of this, or 5%, for your parish Church. The other 5% goes to your favorite charities.

Earlier this week I was given a report on our "We Are Living Stones" Capital Campaign. It showed that over \$177.000 has been pledged by 73 families in our parish. I also know that a number of additional pledges we sent in after that report was printed. I want to sincerely thank all those who have made a commitment to be part of this important fund-raising effort.

I also want to ask all those who have not done so yet to prayerfully consider making a pledge to this Campaign. I know our goal \$677,293 seems unreachable but if everyone is willing to play their part I am confident that we can.

This Capital Campaign is extremely important to St. Mary's. There are a number of important projects that we plan to undertake to improve our parish. The most important of these projects is the installation of an elevator that would serve both the upper and lower Church. I have met with a local contractor who has done this work before and has provided me with a proposal. None of these projects will become a reality without your participation in the "We Are Living Stones" Capital Campaign.

Over the course of the next several weeks, members of the Capital Campaign committee will be reaching out to those parishioners who have yet to make a pledge. If you have any questions about this Capital Campaign, please contact me directly. To the best of my ability, I am ready to answer any and all questions and I am ready to listen to all your comments. As a parish, we need to move forward with our gaze fixed on the future of St. Mary's.






