**Karyn Glover to Speak About
Organ Donations**

Almost two dozen people die each day in the United States while waiting for donor organs and more than 120,000 people remain on waiting lists. One organ donation can save six to eight lives and change the lives of many more that are waiting for life changing organs such as corneas and skin.

Just two months before his death, Bergenfield resident Danny Glover told his mother that if he were to die, he wanted his organs to be donated to help others. Danny was involved in a motor vehicle accident in January of 2012 and passed away nine days later at the age of 24. Danny's mother Karyn has engaged herself in spreading the word about how her son's life lives on in others through the donation of his organs.

We invite you to hear her personal story and learn more about how you can help save lives. Karyn will speak at the Knights of Columbus Hall in Dumont on Monday June 20th at 8:30PM. New Jersey State Assemblyman Robert Auth, who has sponsored legislation to remove fees associated with changing the organ donor status on New Jersey driver's licenses, will also be present.

The hall is located at 61 Armour Place (just off Prospect Avenue) in Dumont NJ 07628.

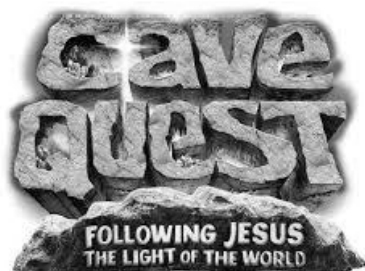
