Spiritual Adoption Program

We have a new program called Spiritual Adoption Program. Participants in the program pledge to pray daily for nine months for a baby in danger of abortion. While this child will remain unknown to his or her 'spiritual parents' many people have found that naming 'their child' helps to keep them focused on the reality that their prayers are helping to save the baby (and the mother) from the harm of abortion.

You will find at the doors of the church spiritual adoption and prayer cards. Please take a prayer card and pray the ten-second prayer daily for your "adopted child". You are also encouraged to name your baby and give him or her identity.
