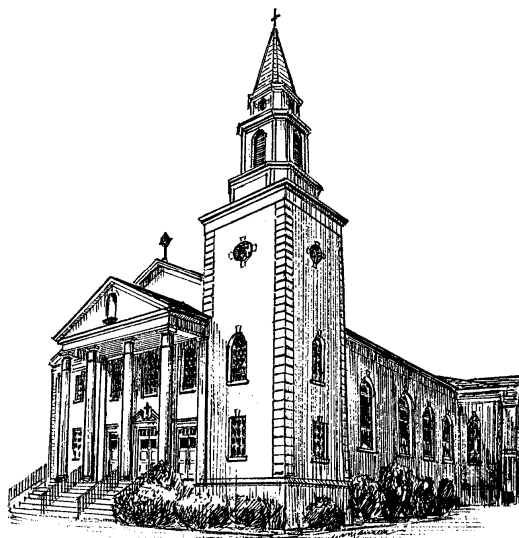

## **Sacrament of Baptism**

Parents should register for the Baptism Preparation Program at the rectory...even before the baby is born!

## **Catechumenate**

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process by which adults (and children who have reached the age of reason) are prepared to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. If you, or someone you know, would like to inquire about becoming a Catholic, please call the parish office.

## **Ministry to the Sick and Homebound**

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is available to be celebrated with anyone in need. Please do not wait until death is imminent to contact the parish regarding an ill family member. Eucharistic Ministers and others serve our community by visiting and bringing Communion to the sick and homebound. Please call the parish office if you wish such a visit.

Tithing is God's plan to support His Church. Full tithing means 10% of gross income to God. We ask half of this, or 5%, for your parish Church. The other 5% goes to your favorite charities.

# From the Pastor

The year 2017 marks the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the restoration of the diaconate as a full and permanent order of the Universal Church. In 1967, Vatican Council II, in its Dogmatic Constitution on the Church (Lumen Gentium 29) laid out the fundamental groundwork for the renewal of the sacred order of deacon as a full, viable and permanent order in the Church.

In the past 50 years, over 19,000 men have been ordained to the permanent diaconate. Most of these are married men with families who have been called by God to serve the Church as ordained ministers. Permanent deacons do not have the full faculties of the priesthood but they may baptize, preside at wedding ceremonies and are called to preach the Gospel. In a world where the number of priests continues to decline, the role of the deacons continues to take a greater significance.

Cardinal Tobin has written asking that we all join him in observing the celebratory year of the deacon which kicks-off in the Archdiocese of Newark on Sunday, October 8, 2017. As we celebrate the permanent diaconate, I would ask that all the mem of our parish to prayerfully consider the question; is God calling you to the permanent diaconate? Do you know a Catholic gentleman who might make a good deacon? As we pray for an increase in vocations to priesthood and religious life, we must also pray for an increase in vocations to the permanent diaconate.

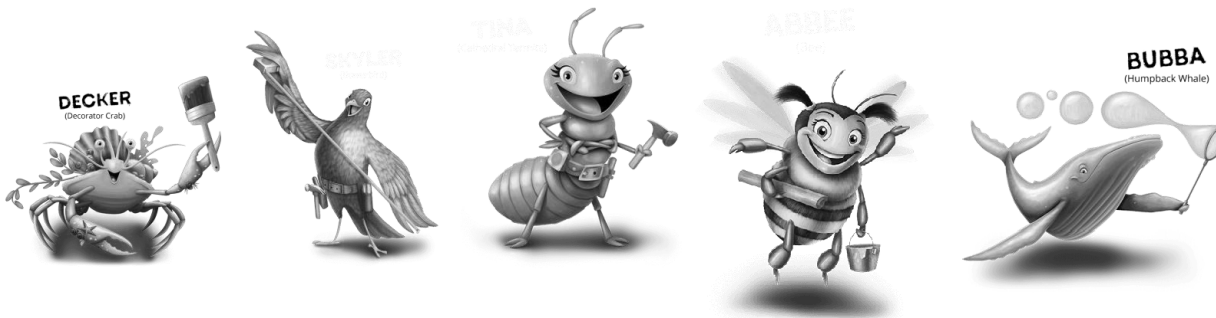
