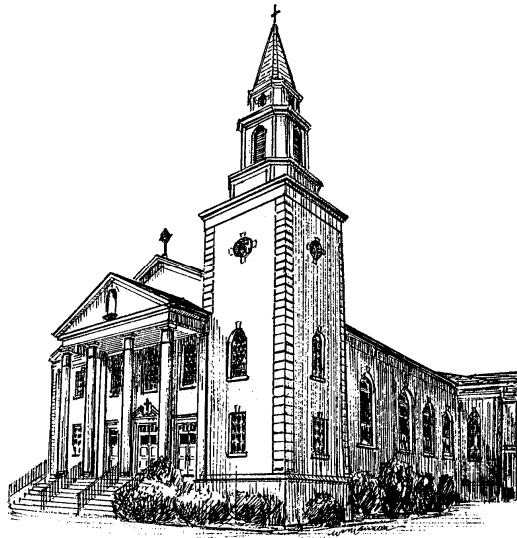

Catechumenate

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process by which adults (and children who have reached the age of reason) are prepared to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. If you, or someone you know, would like to inquire about becoming a Catholic, please call the parish office.

Ministry to the Sick and Homebound

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is available to be celebrated with anyone in need. Please do not wait until death is imminent to contact the parish regarding an ill family member. Eucharistic Ministers and others serve our community by visiting and bringing Communion to the sick and homebound. Please call the parish office if you wish such a visit.

Last Wednesday, October 2nd, our Archbishop, Cardinal Tobin presented his vision for the future of our Archdiocese at meeting held at St. Peter's Church in River Edge. This was one of four meetings the Archbishop is holding across the Archdiocese.

As stated on the Archdiocesan Website, **"Forward in Faith Together: Our Road Ahead"** is Cardinal Tobin's pastoral vision for the Archdiocese of Newark. It seeks to establish a positive path forward for the faithful, the clergy, and the Archdiocese while simultaneously addressing crucial challenges of the past and present. It is a foundation for healing that addresses the hurt and mistrust within our community, reinforces the changes we have begun to implement, and provides a firm foundation for our lives as missionary disciples of Jesus. The documents below are a sampling of resources available to everyone."

The insert in today's bulletin lays out the six pillars of the program. This program was first released last spring at Eastertime. Since then, the Cardinal and his staff have listened to so many across the Archdiocese to refine the program so that it better reflects our needs and our concerns.

Dumont Cub Scouts

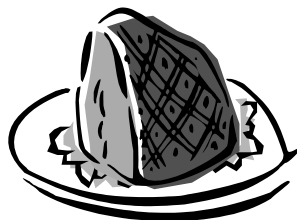

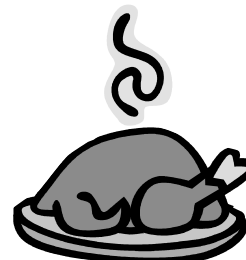
Thanksgiving Baskets
