through the prophets.

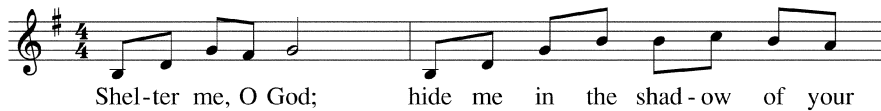
I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church.



Jesus, so that I may be close to all our sisters and brothers, especially those who are most in need of your loving care. Amen.

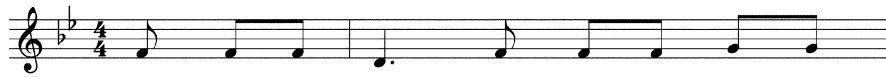
