Eucharistic Adoration - March 5th



On Friday, March 5th, we will have Eucharistic Adoration at 6:00pm in the Upper Church. Reposition begins at 7:00 p.m. Please join us and spend some time with Jesus.

Mass Attendance

The Governor has lifted the restrictions for houses of worship to 50% of capacity, while still maintaining 6 ft social distancing between members of different households. At St. Mary's this means that we can safely now accommodate up to 300 people. Therefore, it will no longer be necessary to "reserve" a seat to our Sunday masses.

The following guidelines for mass attendance are still in place:

- Masks must be worn
- A social distance of 6 ft must be maintained between households, so please sit on either end of our pews and do not sit in the middle. This allows for 6ft between households.
- When you enter church, please use the hand sanitizer provided.
- You may enter and leave the church from any door.
- Follow all directions for the distribution of communion.
- After mass, please do not congregate in the aisles talking; leave the church as quickly as possible.

Cardinal Tobin has directed that the reopening of churches be a gradual process, which means we will continue to live stream the 10 am Mass.

The obligation to attend mass remains suspended for the time-being.

We will celebrate Stations of the Cross in the upper church all Fridays of Lent at 7:30 pm in the Upper Church. Each week we will do the stations using a different meditation format (socially

Our Archbishop, Cardinal Joseph Tobin has issued a Pastoral Letter on the Eucharist entitled "Returning to Grace." He has done this to address what he calls the "Great Eucharistic Fast" imposed on the faithful by the COVID-19 pandemic. Because of this pandemic, churches across our nation were forced to close their doors effectively denying parishioners the opportunity to receive the Body and Blood of our Lord in the Eucharist.

As conditions have allowed for a slow and safe return of the faithful to the celebration of the Eucharist, fear of the virus has understandably led many to choose not to return to mass. Others have chosen to return to mass but still refrain from receiving the Eucharist. For so many Catholics, the Eucharist Fast continues.

The Cardinal's Pastoral Letter calls each of us to reflect on what the Eucharist means to us and what it means to our Catholic identity. As a community of faith, we are united as the Body of Christ nourished by the Body of Christ. This letter is a call to return to the grace that can only be found in the Sacrament of the Eucharist.

The Cardinal's Pastoral Letter can be found on the Archdiocesan website, <u>rcan.org</u>. I would encourage everyone to use the letter as spiritual reading during the days of Lent so that we might all be better prepared to celebrate the paschal mystery of Easter.

RCIA News: Ashley Munoz

Yes we have a candidate for Baptism, our Elect is Ashley Munoz. She and her husband Christian Munoz live in Dumont with their 2-year old daughter Christina. She is a labor and delivery nurse at Columbia Presbyterian in NYC. Ashley came to us 2 years ago inquiring about joining the Catholic faith herself, after she and husband had their daughter baptized. Upon investigation it was determined that while Ashlev had a Christian upbringing in another faith tradition, she had never been baptized. She entered our RCIA process in 2019 and on February 16, 2020 she celebrated the Rite of Acceptance into the Order of the Catechumenate with our parish community. Since that time she has been meeting with our catechists, myself, Barbara Barba and Tom Connelly on pretty much a weekly basis (we took a bit of time off when Covid-19 hit until we figured out we could meet via Zoom). Throughout this process Ashley has been faithful and open to where God is leading her. This past Saturday, she and her godparent went with me to the Cathedral Basilica of the Sacred Heart in Newark to celebrate the Rite of Election with Cardinal Tobin.

Ashley is now beginning her final preparation for Baptism at the Easter Vigil on April 3, 2021.
