

Reinstating the General Obligation to Attend Mass

The Catholic Bishops of New Jersey, are lifting the dispensation of the Sunday and Holy Days Mass obligation **beginning on Saturday, June 5, 2021, and Sunday, June 6, 2021**, Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

Safety protocols are still in place.

The following are guidelines for mass attendance:

- Masks must be worn
- A social distance of 6 ft must be maintained between households, so please sit on either end of our pews and do not sit in the middle. This allows for 6ft between households.
- When you enter church, please use the hand sanitizer provided.
- Please enter the church by way of the 2 side doors by the tabernacle or St. Joseph's altar.
- You may leave the church by any door.
- Follow all directions for the distribution of communion.
- After mass, please do not congregate in the aisles talking; leave the church as quickly as possible.

The 10 am Mass will continue to be live streamed.

Last weekend, 6 men were ordained as transitional deacons. God willing, next year these men will be ordained priests. This weekend, 5 men were ordained as priests for the Archdiocese of Newark. While our Archdiocese is blessed in the number of men who are being ordained, each year the numbers decrease and the numbers are nowhere near what is needed to replace those priests who are retiring.

We, as a Church, must confront the challenge of fewer priests. We must also work to promote vocations. Sometimes, simply asking a young man if he's ever considered the priesthood is enough to begin the discernment of a vocation. Many of us know a young man or a not-so-young man who might make a good priest. Maybe we should ask the question.

But even more than that, we all need to pray for those who have just been ordained. They are entering the priesthood at a time when the Church is facing some unique challenges. The potential for becoming discouraged is very real. Let us pray that God will make them strong in their faith and compassionate in their ministry. Under the protection of Mary, Mother of all priests, may they be faithful shepherd of God's holy people.

Are You Registered?

We have people coming to St. Mary's on a regular basis who need a form of some kind filled out and, when we check our records, we find that they are not registered parishioners.
