Are You Registered?

If you have recently moved or even if you have been attending for years, stop by the parish office and register.

Why do you need to register?

There are many reasons such as:

- There's a feeling of becoming part of the parish community.
- You give the parish a chance to get to know you better.
- The parish will have a way to communicate with you by sending you emails or mails to keep you up-to-date on the parish news.
- Registration is required to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, First Reconciliation or First Penance, Holy Communion, Confirmation and Holy Matrimony.
- If you're planning to register your child(ren) to our religious education program, the families attending must be registered of those parishioners.
- When a person has been asked to be a Godparent or sponsor or if a parish needs verification of your status as a practicing Catholic, these can't be done if you're not registered. You need to be registered as an active parishioner for several months.

Registering is easy. Come to the parish office and register! Office hours are Monday - Thursday, 9:00am -5:00pm; Friday 9:00am - 3:00pm and closed for lunch 1:00pm - 2:00pm.



Recently, someone asked when we would return to taking up a regular collection. I answered that archdiocesan directive allow us to do so but only if we have ushers using a basket on a pole. The archdiocese doesn't want us passing a basket from person to person. In these days of the continuing covid crisis, this makes a great deal of sense. Our problem here at St. Mary's is that our pews are so long, a basket on a pole is really not a viable option. So as long as we face the threat of covid contamination, we will continue using the collection boxes at the doors of the church. I am so proud to say that most parishioners faithfully and generously support our church and for that, I am truly grateful.

When the covid crisis started however, many parishioners made the choice to use electronic giving as a way to continue supporting St. Mary's. Have you ever considered this option?

As you can see by the flyer in this week's bulletin, WESHARE, the company that manages our electronic giving has a special Donor Match Program for those parishioners who sign-up to participate. If you have ever considered electronic giving, now is the time to join the program.

However you choose to support St. Mary's, your donations are always appreciated. Please be assured of our continued prayers as we move forward seeking a new normal.

Confirmation Parent and Candidate Meeting 11/29/2021


