As required by the Archdiocese, this week's bulletin includes our Annual Report on the financial state of the parish. You will note that St. Mary's operating deficit has increased as a result of the loss of rental income. In large part, this loss in rental income is a result of the flood caused by a broken pipe in our school building. We are working hard to increase this rental income. At the same time, we are seeking ways to increase our fund raising efforts. As you can see from the report, we are also working hard to reduce our operating expenses.

As our parish emerges from the covid crisis, we are seeking ways to ensure that St. Mary's operates with a balanced budget. The fact that we are doing as well as we are is thanks to the generosity of our parishioners. I thank you for continued support of St. Mary's and I ask for your prayers as we move forward.

They have about 60+ children, in addition to approximately 35-40 moms they hope to assist this year.


