




This is the day, this is the day, Christ, our Sav-ior is born!

He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end.



I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.








The Lord's Prayer Sign of Peace Lamb of God




# It Came upon the Midnight Clear

## Communion Meditation: Silent Night






