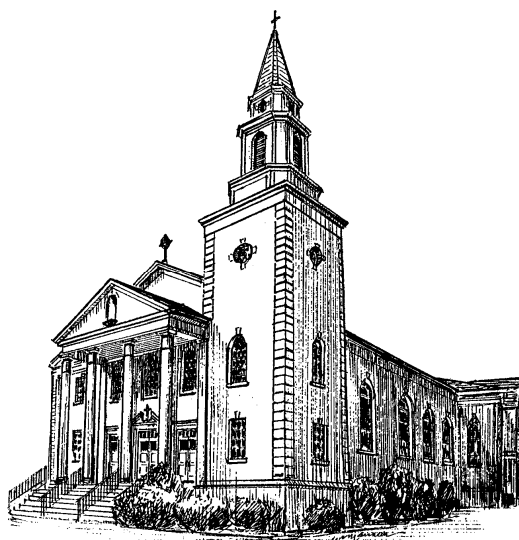

Thank you to all the parishioners of St. Mary's and residents of Dumont who continue to support the food pantry. Mark your calendars for our next drive through food donation on Saturday, June 11 from 10 am to 12 noon. Please see the attached flyer for additional information. If you need bags to bring your food donations to the drive through or the rectory, bags will be placed in boxes at the doors of the church beginning Saturday, May 21st.

IMPORTANT: A single use plastic and paper bag ban went into effect on May 4th in the state of New Jersey. We are hoping to distribute to our clients using paper ream boxes. If you have access to paper ream boxes and can donate them to the pantry, please drop the boxes to the rectory between the hours of 9 am and 5 pm, Monday - Friday. We will need approximately 450 boxes a year.
