### Fifth Sunday of Lent

"Jesus said to her, 'Did I not tell you that if you believe you will see the glory of God?""

JOHN 11:40

Many of us say that we believe in God. We attend Sunday Mass and participate in parish events. But when life gets hard and the pressure is on, when things aren't going our way, do we really believe? Do we really put our trust in the Lord? When we live a life of gratitude, recognizing all that we have been given, we really do see that God is providing for our needs. Living a grateful and generous life allows us to see God's active presence in our daily lives and we become "partakers of the divine nature."



For a week, St. Mary's was blessed by the ministry of three Redemptorist priests here to present a Parish Mission. For a week, Fr. James Wallace, Fr. Francis Gargani and Fr. Philip Dabney were part of all the ministries of St. Mary's.

On Saturday, they presided over our Spring Anointing of the Sick Mass. They presided and preached at all of the Sunday liturgies and they also presented the lesson for our Sunday Religious Education Program. Then, for the next three evenings, they presented the mission, Feeding the Hungers of the Heart. Each evening, over 150 people attended the Mission and I truly believe that everyone who attended were spiritual moved by the presentations.

Putting together a mission like this takes a great deal of work and I want to thank everyone who contributed to the success of the mission especially our three visiting priests. But the true success of the mission can only be measured by the way it affect our parish as we move forward.

Hopefully, the mission challenged each one of us to reevaluate our relationship with God and with His Church; to reevaluate how faithful we follow Christ and serve Christ by serving our brothers and sisters. As baptized Catholics, each one of us is called to share in the priesthood of Jesus. Hopefully our Parish Mission will help each to reexamine how we are doing and how we can do more.

The archdiocese is excited to announce that they are once again preparing the annual tradition of honoring those couples in our Archdiocese who will be celebrating five, twenty-five and fifty years of valid marriage for the Catholic faithful in the year 2023!

These anniversary liturgies will be celebrated in the Cathedral Basilica of the Sacred Heart in Newark as follows:

### **Celebrated by Cardinal Joseph Tobin:**

April 16, 2023 3:00 PM 50 years (All counties)

### Celebrated by Bishop Gregory Studerus:

May 7, 2023 3:00 PM 5 years & 25 years (All counties)

It is our desire that every couple in the Archdiocese deserving of such recognition be present at the appropriate liturgy. The presence of a large number of couples will be a tender witness to the strength and stability of Christian marriage in today's society. Since they we were unable to host these celebrations in 2020 and 2021, and many families are still playing 'catch up' with their celebrations, any couple who would have celebrated their Silver or Gold Anniversary in those years can also join them. Please note, whether the milestone anniversary took place in 2020, 2021 or 2022, the certificates will still say Silver or Gold, not 26, 51 etc.
