The Most Holy Trinity

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son..." JOHN 3:16

Is your love conditional? Is there a price others have to pay to receive your love and forgiveness? Are you generous with your time, skills, money and possessions? If you give someone something, do you expect something in return? Do you give your time freely or do you "fit it in" when it's convenient for you? This weekend, as we celebrate the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity, we are honored to welcome Bishop John Flesey back to St. Mary's for the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation. This year, 47 young members of our parish community will be Sealed with the gifts of the Holy Spirit. For these young people, this sacrament is meant to be the start of new, more mature practice of their Catholic faith. Sadly, many youngsters see Confirmation as their graduation from Religious Education and the end of any real participation in the life of the Church.


