

Vigil to Remember Victims of Gun Violence

It has been twelve years since 20 children and six faculty members at Sandy Hook Elementary School were killed while going about their normal activities. The deaths shocked the nation at the time, but since then there have been many more mass shootings — at schools, during concerts, in houses of worship, at places of work, at restaurants. In short, wherever people gather.

On next Sunday, December 17th, after the 10:00 Mass, three days after the anniversary of the Sandy Hook shooting, we will once again hold a vigil on the steps of the church to pray for all affected by mass shootings and an end to all violence, particularly mass shootings. The vigil will last about 10 minutes, with the toiling of the bells 26 times and ending by singing "Let There Be Peace on Earth."

Please plan on joining your fellow parishioners at this vigil.

Memorial Bricks for the St. Mary's Prayer Garden


