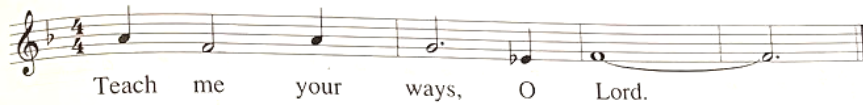

## Nicene Creed
