

THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT



A few weeks back, on Ash Wednesday, we entered into the sacred season of Lent. When we began this Lenten journey, many of us made a commitment to engage in some special penance, to give up some special food or behavior, or, perhaps we had decided to participate in some special spiritual exercise. Each of us made some commitment to making this Lent special so that we would be better prepared to celebrate Easter.

Well, how are we doing? Are we still committed to making this Lent special or have we given up? Have we persevered in our Lenten commitments or have they, like our New Year's resolutions, been quickly abandoned? Maybe we never even started our Lenten commitments because we knew that it was doomed to failure.

ANNUAL²⁰²⁴APPEAL


