

## Stewardship Reflection

#### 3rd Sunday of Easter

"Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, 'Peace be with you.' But they were startled and frightened..." - LUKE 24:36-37

Throughout the day we have many opportunities to "see the face of Jesus" in others and to "be the face of Jesus" to others. Do we take that opportunity to provide "peace" to those we encounter or are we afraid of what others will think of us and do nothing? Pray for the strength and courage to live a "God-centered" life and not a "self-centered" life.



On April 14, 1963, sixty-one years ago today, the current St. Mary's Church was dedicated by Archbishop Thomas Boland. Much has happened in the years since our church was dedicated. There have been numerous changes and so many different priests have served the pastoral needs of our parishioners.

Two weeks ago, at the Easter Vigil, when I had the privilege of baptizing Anthony John O'Brien, the newest member of St. Mary's parish, I considered how other individuals were welcomed into the Catholic Church at our baptismal font. I also thought about how many youngsters received the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation at St. Mary's and how young couples were married at our altar. And of course, I considered how many times a funeral mass was celebrated at St. Mary's for one of our faithful parishioners as they were being sent home to God.

True, the Church of St. Mary's is magnificent structure but what makes it so historic is the believers who have passed through our doors to celebrate God's love, to participate in the rites of the Catholic Church and to share in the Good News of Salvation.

In my travels, I have visited many beautiful churches but what makes a church special is not the art or the architecture. It is the faithful people who come together to worship. As the current pastor of St. Mary's, I am profoundly aware that I have been entrusted with an incredible legacy. I hope that together, we can build on the accomplishments of those who came before us as we work to ensure a vibrant future for St. Mary's.

PACT is a family program provided for all parish families with children in grades 1-8 who do not attend Catholic schools (we also have a small Kindergarten group). Children who attend regular Religious Education or Catholic school are then prepared separately for First Communion, Penance, and Confirmation.

The archdiocese is once again preparing the annual tradition of honoring those couples in our Archdiocese who will be celebrating five, twenty-five and fifty years of valid marriage for the Catholic faithful in the year 2024!

These anniversary liturgies will be held in the Cathedral Basilica of the Sacred Heart in Newark as follows below and will be celebrated by Cardinal Joseph Tobin:

May 5, 2024 12:00 PM 5 years & 25 years (All counties)

June 2, 2024 12:00 PM 50 years (All counties)

It is our desire that every couple in the Archdiocese deserving of such recognition be present at the appropriate liturgy. The presence of a large number of couples will be a tender witness to the strength and stability of Christian marriage in today's society.

Any couple who would have celebrated their Silver or Gold Anniversary in those years stunted by covid restrictions may still join them. Please note, whether the milestone anniversary took place in 2020, 2021, 2022 or 2023, the certificates will still say Silver or Gold, not 26, 51 etc.

If you would like to participate in one of these liturgies, you need to come to the parish office and fill in a registration form so that they know the names and the number of those attending each liturgy.
