



## Feast of Corpus Christi

"Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them and they all drank from it." - MARK 14:23

Jesus, the perfect steward, gave thanks, just before He gave Himself up for us, completely for our salvation. He offers us the same chance to drink from His cup. In the bread and wine, we meet Christ personally. If we follow Him, drinking from His cup means we offer our own self-sacrifice, using all of our gifts for the benefit of others and to do His work on earth.

### THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI) JUNE 2, 2024



Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, traditionally called Feast of Corpus Christi. Two months ago, on Holy Thursday, we celebrated the institution of the Eucharist. Today we celebrate the Real Presence of Christ in this Sacrament; we celebrate the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus in the Eucharist.

This feast dates back the 13<sup>th</sup> Century. It was proposed by St. Thomas Aquinas and was instituted by Pope Urban IV in order to create a feast focused solely on the Holy Eucharist. Traditionally, this feast was celebrated on the Thursday following Trinity Sunday and was considered a Holy Day of Obligation. In days gone by, large Eucharistic processions would be part of the celebration of this great feast.

This year, as we celebrate this feast perhaps we might recall the joy and wonder we felt when we received First Holy Communion. For me, this feast always reminds me of the countless times I have had the privilege of giving someone Viaticum. Viaticum is given to someone who is dying. It is the last Communion a person received and it literally means "Food for the Journey." Perhaps, every time we receive Holy Communion we should consider it Food for the Journey. We always need to remember, that on the journey of life Christ is always with us. In the Eucharist, we know we have the Real Presence of Our Lord.
