

Once again, St. Mary's is hosting a big 50/50 Mega Raffle. When we did this for the past four years, the pot exceeded \$45,000. It would be great if,


this year, we could reach \$50,000. I'm sure everyone would like to win a share of such a large pot.

Our next Sunday PACT sessions will be 1/5 and 1/12. As usual, check your color-coded schedules for your full schedule and work to be completed at home.


