Blessing of Throats

St. Blaisé's Feast will be on Monday, Feb. 3rd. Those who wish for the traditional imposition of candles are welcome to come forward at the end of the Mass.





Forty days after the birth of Jesus, today the Church celebrates the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. This day is also known as Candlemas Day since a special blessing of candles is included in today's liturgy. We bless candles on this feast because, as we hear in today's Gospel, Jesus is the light that reveals the God of Israel to all the nations. According to the old church calendar this feast of the Presentation was considered the official end of the Christmas season. In some places, the Christmas Crèche remains until the celebration of this feast.

In 1976, Pope St. John Paul II declared that this day would also be a World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life. He attached it to "Candlemas Day" because consecrated men and women are called to be the light in the world, imitating Jesus, the Light of the World.

On this Feast of the Presentation of our Lord, let us remember the joy we celebrated at Christmas, we are called to celebrate each and every day because Jesus is always with us. Let us also pray for an increase in vocations to consecrated life as we remember the special men and women who may have inspired us to help bring the light of Christ to a world in need.
