

"No longer was there manna for the Israelites, who that year ate of the yield of the land of Canaan." - JOSHUA 5:12


Patient Privacy Reminder

I'm happy to announce that we \$1,065.00 raised to support Edlene Saintimond and her three children as they go through Borders' Beyond Family Graduation Program. Once they complete this 2-year program, with our financial support, they will have a secure place to live, a steady income, and her children will be attending school. They will be self-sufficient.

Updates for this family will be in the bulletin, our weekly email and in the bulletin. The next appeal for donations will be around November, as our total commitment is \$100 per month, for a total of \$2,400.

We are not only supporting this family financially. We have given them hope, hope that they will be able to live a productive life, a life of dignity. In one sense, we are doing this for ourselves: "Hope is the gift we receive when we give all the hope that we have away" (Father Daniel Berrigan, SJ).

I'm grateful to be part of this community that cares for our brothers and sisters in our community who face food insecurity by supporting our food pantry, who weekly support our church and serve others outside our immediate community, such as the Nurturing Place in Jersey City, the group that sends disabled persons to Lourdes for a spiritual experience, and a family in Haiti facing multiple issues. That is truly following the teaching of Jesus.
