After many years of prayer and fund raising, our dream of having a real elevator for St. Mary's church is getting closer to being a reality. Last fall, the construction of the actual elevator tower began. Of course before you can do construction you very often have to do some destruction; which is what happened to the one set of stairs on the side of the church. Once the old stairs were removed, a tower for the new elevator was built and I am more than pleased with the results. I think the company that built the tower did an exceptional job.


While one company was building the tower on site, a different company was fabricating the actual elevator at the factory. That company is a little behind in schedule but after a couple of delays; I have been informed that delivery of the elevator will begin within the next two weeks. The elevator will be delivered in pieces and will be assembled as it is installed in the new tower. This process will take approximately 3 to 4 weeks. This means that in the very near future, St. Mary's will have an actual elevator.

For many years, those who could not manage the stairs had to rely on the outside wheel-chair lift. I am truly grateful to PALAD and to all those who provided St. Mary's with this lift. But after many years of use, the time has come for St. Mary's to have a real elevator and to be truly handicapped assessable. This would never have been possible without the generous support of so many people. To all who contributed to the construction of the elevator, I offer my sincere thanks.
