THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER



A great marker of how vibrant a parish is, very often can be the number of parishioners who are receiving the sacraments. This Easter season shows just how well St. Mary's is doing. At the Easter Vigil, we welcomed a member of our parish into the Catholic Church with the Sacraments of Initiation; Baptism, Confirmation and First Eucharist.

Last Sunday, 2 more parishioners completed their initiation into the Catholic faith. One received the Sacrament of Confirmation, the other received Confirmation and First Eucharist.

This weekend will begin First Holy Communion for the youngsters in our Religious Education Program. We will again celebrate First Holy Communion in 2 weeks. St. Mary's has 80 students making First Holy Communion this year.

The weekend in between, we will welcome Bishop John Flesey to St. Mary's for the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation for the older students in our Religious Education Program. We have 50 students who will be Confirmed this year.

This has been a very busy time for St. Mary's; but it's a very good busy. Having just finished the celebration of Holy Week and Easter and moving directly into celebration of the sacraments for Religious Education students as well as for adults being initiated or completing their initiation has been a tremendous celebration of our faith and clearly displays the vibrancy of our parish. Let us pray for all those who have or will soon receive the Sacraments of the Church. Let us also pray for the College of Cardinals who will soon begin the Conclave that will choose the next Pope. Let us place our trust in the Holy Spirit who has guided the Catholic Church for more than 2 thousands years and always will.


