

SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER



The Memorial Day weekend is finally here. For many, it means the official start of the summer season. The beaches are open, pools are ready and family barbecues are the order of the day. But in all the plans we make for the first holiday weekend of the summer, all too often we forget the real reason for the holiday. This is more than just an opportunity to kick-off the summer season. This day is given to us as a Memorial for all the men and women who have paid the ultimate sacrifice for our nation. This is a day of remembrance. A day to appreciate the liberties we all too often take for granted and to say a prayer of thanksgiving for all the men and women who died to protect these liberties.

But even as we pray for all those who have died, we must also pray for those who continue to risk their lives in the cause of peace. Men and women in military service have accepted the challenge to defend our nation and the ideal for which we stand. In gratitude for them and for all those who went before them, for all who have donned the uniform of the country and served with pride, let us each take some time this Memorial Day weekend to remember; remember what we have and remember those who died that we might have it.

As we pray for those who serve our country, we must all pray for those who have been called to serve our church. Last Sunday, Cardinal Tobin ordained 8 men as transitional deacons and 19 men as permanent deacons. Yesterday, the Cardinal ordained 3 men as priests. As we pray for these newly ordained men, we must also pray that more men and women will respond to God's call to ordained ministry and to consecrated life.

These newly ordained men are entering ministry when our Church and our Archdiocese are confronting some unique challenges. Let us pray that God will make them strong in their faith and compassionate in their ministry. Under the protection of Mary, Mother of all priests, may they be faithful shepherd of God's holy people.
