

At the end of May, Cardinal Tobin ordained 3 new priests for service in the Archdiocese of Newark. While it was wonderful to welcome 3 new members to our priestly brotherhood, I was saddened that it was only 3 new priests. When I was ordained more than 25 years ago, there were 16 of us ordained together. If we were to go back even further, it was not unusual for more than 20 new priests to be ordained in a single year. While the number of new priests declines, the number of retired priests continues to grow. Currently there are over 200 retired priests in the Archdiocese of Newark.

Next weekend, we will have a special collection to support the fund for retired priests in the Archdiocese of Newark. This fund provides for pension benefits for retired priests as well as their insurance coverage. While the priests pension fund in mostly supported by the Archdiocese with assistance from the Annual Appeal, the growing number of retired priests is starting to cause strain on the fund which is why we need this special collection.

Many retired priests live in rectories or in one of the two retirement homes the Archdiocese maintains. Many others live with families. As much as they are able to do so, most retired priests remain active in ministry. I am grateful that Fr. David Milliken decided to live with us here at St. Mary's and is always ready to help meet the ministerial needs of our parishioners.

Our participation in the collection for Retired Priest is our way of saying thank you to all the priests who have given their lives in service to the Church and who continue to give to us through their ministry and through their prayers.

Are You Registered?

If you have recently moved or even if you have been attending for years, stop by the parish office and register.

Why do you need to register?

There are many reasons such as:

- There's a feeling of becoming part of the parish community.
- You give the parish a chance to get to know you better.
- The parish will have a way to communicate with you by sending you emails or mails to keep you up-to-date on the parish news.
- **Registration is required** to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, First Reconciliation or Penance, First Holy Communion, Confirmation and Holy Matrimony.
- If you're planning to register your child(ren) to our **Religious Education program**, the families of those attending must be registered parishioners.
- When a person has been asked to be a Godparent or sponsor or if a parish needs verification of your status as a practicing Catholic, these can't be done if you're not registered. You need to be registered as an active parishioner for at least three months.

Registering is easy. Come to the parish office and register! Office hours are Monday - Thursday, 9:00am -5:00pm, Friday 9:00am-3:00pm and closed for lunch 1:00pm - 2:00pm.
