

Earlier this year, our Archbishop, Cardinal Tobin, published a letter, "We Are His Witnesses." This letter introduced us to a process called "Pastoral Conversion." This process is meant to evaluate the current pastoral needs of our Archdiocese, to project the future pastoral needs and to seek the most pastoral and efficient way to meet these needs now and in the future.

Everyone was invited to be part of this process by participating in the Disciples Maker Survey this past spring. I thank all those members of St. Mary's who took the time to complete the survey. From what I have learned, a greater percentage of St. Mary's parishioners participated in the survey than many other parishes.

Last October, all the priest of the Archdiocese had a full-day presentation of the process of Pastoral Conversion. It was also a big part of the three-day Convocation that all priests attended at the end of May. This summer has been a time to collate all the information that has been collected and now it is time to move forward.

In our bulletin today, there is an outline of what the next steps in the process of Pastoral Conversion for the Archdiocese of Newark. Everyone will have the opportunity to be part of the We must all realize the changing process. demographics of Archdiocese, the participation in the life of the parish of many Catholics and the declining number of ordained ministers. As the Cardinal has stresses, the process of Pastoral Conversion calls us to focus on three fundamental questions: Where are we now? Where are we going? How do we get there? Under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, I am confident that the Archdiocese of Newark will be made much stronger by the Pastoral Conversion.




