Once a month, usually on the second Sunday of the month, here at St. Mary's we celebrate the sacrament of baptism. Usually, it's one or two babies. Sometimes it's three or four babies. Occasionally, it's more and sometimes, the babies aren't babies. They're toddlers. But it doesn't matter how many or how old, I love celebrating baptisms.

Today we celebrate the Baptism of our Lord. The baptism of Jesus in waters of the Jordan by his cousin John is what gives meaning to all baptisms. Just as our heavenly Father claimed the newly baptized Jesus as his beloved Son, the Father claims every baptized individual as a beloved son or daughter. The Father's love washes away the stain of Original Sin and bestows the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Whenever I celebrate a baptism, I always say it's a great day. It truly is a great day for the person being baptized because they are claimed as God's own child. It is also a great day for our parish and for the Church Universal because our faith community and our Church are made richer and stronger as we welcome each new member.

Today, as we celebrate the Baptism of Jesus, let's thank God for the countless gifts He has given us, His children, and remember it all began in the waters of Baptism.




