Parish Office Schedule - Jan. 19th



In observance of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. day on Monday, January 19th, the parish office will be closed that day.



On January 22, 1973, the Supreme Court of the United States handed down the Roe v Wade decision which legalized abortion in this nation. In the summer of 2022, the Supreme Court issued a new ruling which vacated the Roe decision leaving the question of the legality of abortion to the laws of each individual state.

Since then, some states have adopted strict draconian laws prohibiting all abortions while other states are working to ensure abortion as a legal option. This patchwork of state laws has caused mass confusion and heated debate regarding this issue.

Every January since 1974, the year after the Roe decision, thousands have gathered in Washington for the annual March for Life. Originally started to protest the Roe decision, this March continues as a celebration of each and every life, from the moment of conception until natural death. It is the largest annual human rights demonstration in the world. This March stresses the need to continue the work to protect all human life at the state and federal levels. This year's March will take place on Friday, January 23rd.

I think it is most important to remember that abortion in this country did not start with Roe v Wade, and abortions will not end even if all the laws are changed. As important as it is to change laws, it is much more important to change hearts and minds. Until everyone acknowledges the dignity and the sanctity of all human life, from conception to natural death, abortions will continue.

I find it extremely ironic that at the same time people work to enact laws to stop abortions, others work to promote laws that permit physician assisted suicide, euthanasia, and the death penalty. If we want to claim the mantle of Pro-Life, we must respect and protect all human life.

If we are truly followers of Christ, we must work to promote a culture of life where all human life is respected and nurtured. This must include the poor, the homeless, the sick and the marginalized in our society. We need to pray for a world where no child goes to bed hungry and no elder person is neglected. Until each and every individual is respected as a child of God, our work in promoting a culture of life is not finished.
