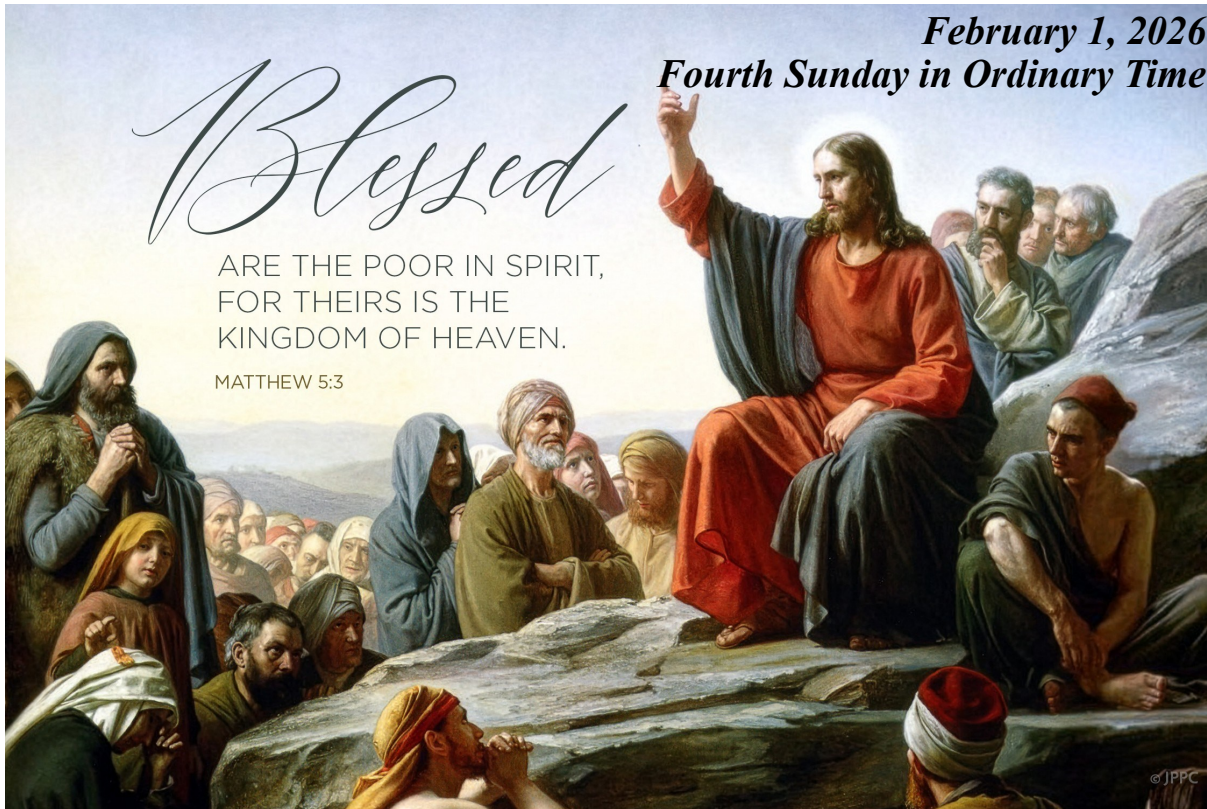

Holy Hour with Eucharistic Adoration - February 6th

Several years ago, in a discussion I was having with a good friend of mine who is a priest in the Episcopal Church, he casually mentioned that one of the things he envied about the Catholic Church was the fact that we had cloistered community of both men and women. I was extremely surprised by this comment thinking what a strange thing to envy about the Catholic Church. When I asked him why, he said, "Don't you realize that at every minute of every day, somewhere in the world there is cloistered community of nuns or brothers praying for your Church?"

Tomorrow, February 2nd, the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, the Catholic Church will celebrate the 30th World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life. This is a day to honor and give thanks for all the men and women who serve the Church in religious communities, those in cloistered life and those who serve in so many active ministries. In addition to those who live in community, our archdiocese is blessed with many individuals who are part of secular institutes, who are consecrated virgins, and those who have taken private vows.

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, also known as Candlemas Day, is celebrated 40 days after the Birth of Christ. It marks the presentation of the infant Jesus in the Temple in Jerusalem. We bless candles on this feast because, as we hear in today's Gospel, Jesus is the light that reveals the God of Israel to all the nations. According to the old church calendar, this feast of the Presentation was considered the official end of the Christmas season. In 1976, Pope St. John Paul II declared that this day would also be a World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life. He attached it to "Candlemas Day" because consecrated men and women are called to be the light in the world, imitating Jesus, the Light of the World.

For more than 170 years, the Archdiocese of Newark has been blessed by the ministry of countless men and women in consecrated life, most especially in education and in health care as well as in parish ministry. They have touched so many lives with their compassion, their care, their ministry, and most importantly, with their prayers. Let us all give thanks for all the women and men in consecrated life who serve the Church and let us all pray that the Church will be blessed with an abundance of vocations to consecrated life and ordained ministry.
