Parents should register for the Baptism Preparation Program at the rectory...even before the baby is born!

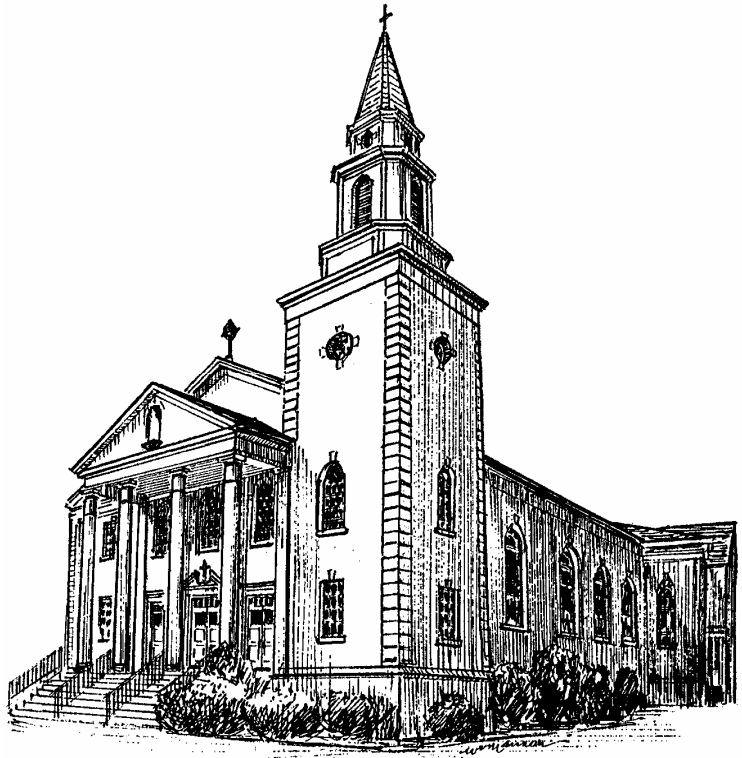

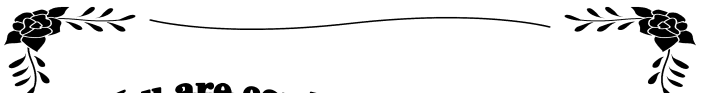

Dear Friends,

This weekend we celebrate the great feast of Pentecost, the birthday of the Church, the promise of the Holy Spirit to be with the Church until Christ comes again. As we celebrate Pentecost this weekend we will also celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation where Sixty 8th graders will receive this same Spirit that came down on the Disciples in that Upper Room that we hear about in Acts of the Apostles. The Spirit gave those first Disciples the gifts they needed to go out and proclaim the Good News of Jesus that they were not to be afraid anymore but to boldly share what they believe with others. That is why it is the birthday of the Church. All of us who receive the Holy Spirit at Confirmation are given those same gifts as the Disciples received in the 1st Century and we too are to boldly proclaim the message of Jesus to all we encounter. 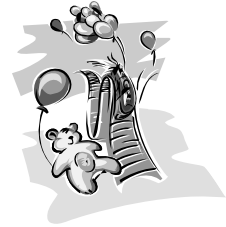
