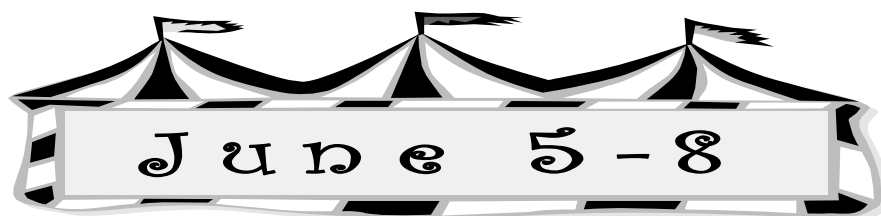

### **Helping Hands Ministry**

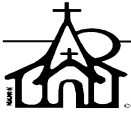

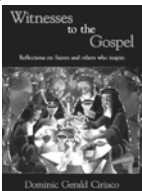

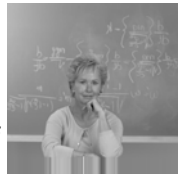
The Catholic School Teachers
