Parents should register for the Baptism Preparation Program at the rectory...even before the baby is born!

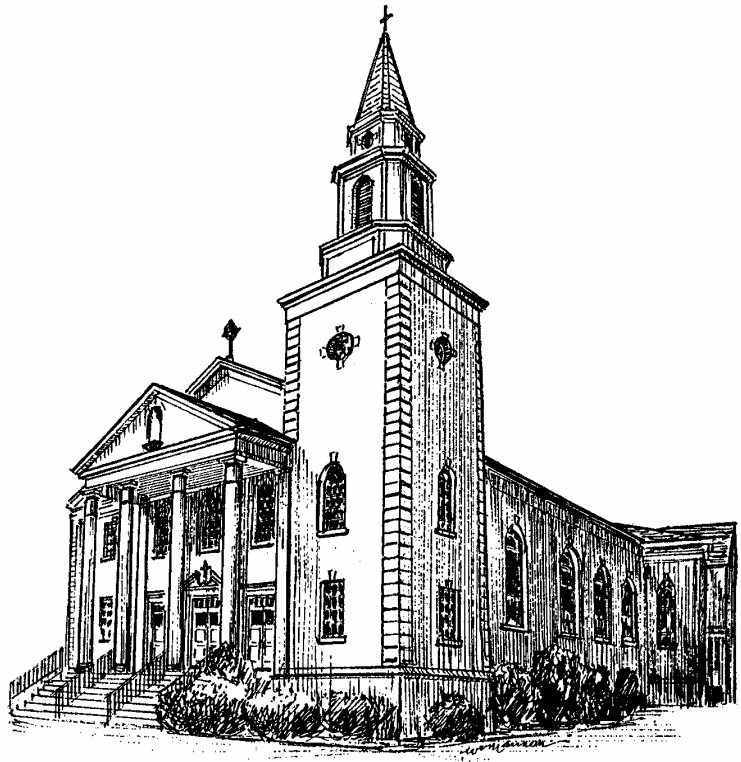

**Dumont Ambulance Corps
75th Anniversary Exhibit**

To mark its 75th Anniversary the Dumont Volunteer Ambulance Corps is sharing its history through an exhibit of 40 photographs and memorabilia. The free Exhibit is in the Dumont Library lower level Exhibit Space and will run until June 30th.

There is a significant connection between St Mary's and the DVAC as many members were also parishioners. Six St. Mary's priests served as Corps Chaplain over the decades. From 1942 through 1955 Father Henry O'Neill served on the Corps Board of Governors. In the 1970's Father Richard Ehrenberg was an actual Active member of the Corps. In many other ways St Mary's Parish has supported the 'Good Samaritan' work of the Ambulance Corps for 75 years. The current DVAC members invite the St Mary's community to enjoy this look back at the history and accomplishments of your friends and neighbors who volunteered to help our town.

**Making a Difference...**

Last month, in the Cathedral Basilica of the Sacred Heart in Newark, Archbishop Myers ordained eight men to the Priesthood and eleven men as transitional Deacons for service to the Church of Newark. Transitional deacons serve in parishes for one year before they are ordained to the priesthood.

While many dioceses in the United States have no candidates for the priesthood and clergy shortages are widespread, the Archdiocese of Newark is blessed with several men each year who are willing to answer God's call to serve, insuring that the Church will be present for future generations. The seminary training and formation of our new priests is funded primarily by the Archbishop's Annual Appeal.
