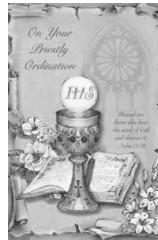

**Sunday, May 25, 2014**

**Gift of the Holy Spirit**



Today's Readings: Acts 8:5–8, 14–17; Psalm 66:1–3, 4–5, 6–7, 16, 20 (1); 1 Peter 3:15–18; John 14:15–21. The early Church wrestled with difficult questions, such as who could be a member of the Church. Through dialogue, conversation, prayer, and the workings of the Holy Spirit, all were called to membership. The early Christians had courage to face conflicts amidst the demands of a pagan world. Fidelity to Christ, the Gospel, and fundamental Christian values required costly, even heroic, sacrifices at times. In all cases, gentleness and reverence won out in the end.

Similar challenges persist in the Church today. Conflicts and factions abound, and yet we are reminded in the Gospel and in the teachings of the Church that we are called to

build up the Body of Christ, to become a sacrament of unity. Today's Gospel asks us to follow the commandments, and when we do so, the Father tells us that Jesus will live in us. The Paraclete, the Holy Spirit, a spirit of truth, continues to lead the Church toward that unity. This Advocate of truth can often seem hidden when we try to work for justice. It is important that we give the Spirit a chance to be the active, transforming agent at work in the Church and in the world, changing not only bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ, but also changing us, that we might be broken and poured out for the life of the world. We must do all that we can to promote this unity as we gather at the banquet table of the Lord.
