As we celebrate Independence Day, here is a reflection for us to think about concerning our basic God given right of freedom and faith.

Adopted on July 4, 1776, the Declaration of Independence stated that the thirteen American colonies were "Free and Independent States" and that "all political connection between them and the State of Great Britain, is and ought to be totally dissolved." Our Founding Fathers acknowledged God as the source of our rights:

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness -That to secure these rights. Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just Powers from the consent of the governed - That whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new Government, laying its foundation on such principles and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their Safety and Happiness...

For the support of his Declaration, with a firm reliance on the protection of Divine Providence, we mutually pledge to each other our Lives, our Fortunes and our sacred Honor.

As Founding Father Benjamin Rush said:

"Without [religion] there can be no virtue, and without virtue there can be no liberty, and liberty is the object and life of all republican governments."

Lord, You gave us our basic rights. May we therefore live as You would have us live. "The Lord gives freedom" (Psalm 146:7)



- Learn about her life and mission from the Sisters themselves.


