PRAYER TO ST JOSEPH – PIUS XII

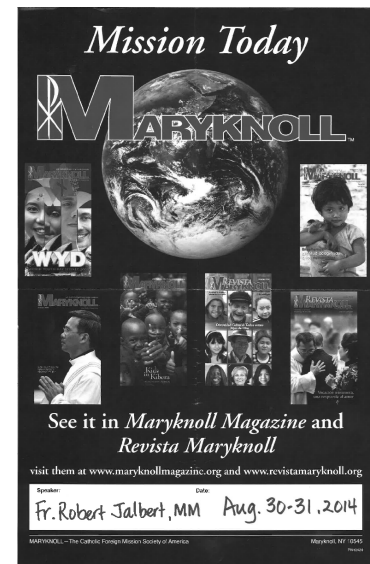
