Advent Penance Service

This year, our Tri-Parish Advent Communal Penance Service for the season of Advent will take place here at St. Mary's, on Monday evening, Dec. 15, at 7:30 PM. This service affords our parishioners to be reconciled with the Lord and each other through this sacrament of healing.



Dear Friends,

We are now at the Third Sunday of Advent, which we call Gaudete Sunday. The Rose Colored Vestment is worn to signify the meaning of this week that is joy. Our Holy Father, Pope Francis, in his most recent Encyclical Letter wrote on the Gospel of Joy. He writes: "The Christian Message is called the gospel (good news), an announcement of joy for all people. The Church is not a haven for sad people but a joyful home! And those who are sad find joy in her, true joy!" These are words of wisdom for us as we continue on our advent journey and as we draw closer to Christmas. Let us pray that we experience this joy that Christ can give us if our hearts are open to it. Let us bring this joy to those we encounter in our everyday living.

I had made the announcement last week at the Daily Masses that beginning Monday, January 5th, we will have only one Daily Mass here at St. Mary's at 8:00AM. This has been something in the works for at least a year. I have consulted the priests here, the staff, our trustees and the Parish Council who all have given me the green light to put this into effect. Since we are not getting a third fulltime priest, I knew that this would be the direction we would go. The 7:00AM is lightly attended and during the week, the chance of several funerals is always there. Many parishes in this area and throughout the Archdiocese offer only one daily Mass and so St. Mary's will be doing the same. Please be assured that when it is a Holy Day of Obligation, there will be three Masses offered. When the Intention Book for 2015 was open last vear, only one mass intention was taken because I knew we were going in this direction. There were no 7:00AM Mass Intentions taken for that time in 2015. If the Mass Intention was taken for 8:45AM, it will now go to the 8:00AM Mass. This was not done to inconvenience anyone but to address the reality of where our local church is heading now. I know change is hard to accept at first but once it is put into effect, it soon will become the norm. There are at least three parishes in the area that have a 7:00AM Mass if some feel inclined to go to an early Mass.


