

#### Dear Friends,

Sunday, **February 8**, is the *first* international day of prayer and awareness against human trafficking. You may have noticed that we prayed for an end to this gross injustice at all our Masses this weekend. Through prayer and action, we can comfort and help empower our brothers and sisters who have suffered through this affront to human dignity. In the words of the Committee Chairman for Migration, Bishop Eusebio Elizondo, M.Sp.S. "If just one person realizes from this day that they or someone they know is being trafficked, we will have made a difference."

February 8 was the date chosen for this international day of prayer and awareness against human trafficking because it is the feast day of **St. Josephine Bakhita**, who was kidnapped as a child and sold into slavery in Sudan and Italy. Once Josephine was freed, she became a Canossian Sister of Charity and dedicated her life to sharing her testament of deliverance from slavery and comforting the poor and suffering. She was declared a Saint in 2000.

The Catholics Confront Global Poverty team of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops and Catholic Relief Services forwarded the following information regarding this issued in a recent letter "The House of Representatives passed H.R. 515, the International Megan's Law to Prevent Demand for Child Sex Trafficking. The International Labor Organization estimates that 1.8 million children are victimized by commercial sexual exploitation every year. This bill will help reduce the demand for child sex tourism, saving the lives and upholding the dignity of countless children. It's also an important contribution towards ending human trafficking by 2020, a goal identified by Pope Francis and other religious leaders. The Senate will have to take up and pass this bill, and the President has to sign it before it can become law."

Let us as a parish community do our part by praying to end this horrific injustice.
