Dear Friends,

This weekend and next weekend at a few of our Masses, we will be celebrating First Holy Communion with our Second Graders. Whenever we celebrate First Holy Communion, it is always a reminder to us of the power and importance of the Eucharist in our lives. I think we take for granted the wonderful gift and mystery that Jesus gives us when we receive His Body and Blood. In our prayer life, we should come to realize how Jesus strengthens us in the Eucharist and enables us to draw closer to Him. In the innocence, excitement, nervousness, and preparedness that these children model for us as they received Jesus in the Eucharist for the first time be an example to us as we approach the altar to receive Jesus.

Many thanks to Dr. Mascitello and the Religious Education teachers who helped prepare these children for this important day in their lives.

May these words from Blessed Elizabeth of the Trinity (1880-1906), Carmelite Mystic, help us to know the importance of the Eucharist in our lives.

"Remain in Me." It is the Word of God who gives this order, expresses this Remain in Me, not for a few wish. moments, a few hours which must pass but "remain..." permanently, habitually, Remain in Me, pray in Me, adore in Me, love in Me, suffer in Me, work and act in Me. Remain in Me so that you may be able to encounter anyone or anything; penetrate further still into these depths. This is truly the "solitude into which God wants to allure the soul that He may speak to it," as the prophet sang [Hos 2:14/2:16].
