

#### Catechumenate

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process by which adults (and children who have reached the age of reason) are prepared to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. If you, or someone you know, would like to inquire about becoming a Catholic, please call the parish office.

#### Ministry to the Sick and Homebound

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is available to be celebrated with anyone in need. Please do not wait until death is imminent to contact the parish regarding an ill family member. Eucharistic Ministers and others serve our community by visiting and bringing Communion to the sick and homebound. Please call the parish office if you wish such a visit.

# PD Reflections

People are different. I think we realize this reality the more people we meet

One of the signs of this is the reaction various people have to hot weather. Some find it oppressive. Others really enjoy it. I am in the first group and thus I prefer spring or fall. I try to stay out of the sun and enjoy the shade, breezes and low humidity.

I once read that there are two ways people learn. Some need to hear things. Others need to read them. I guess that means some people like to read the bulletin. Others prefer homilies or announcements. There are more detailed divisions. The Myers-Briggs personality chart breaks us down into sixteen categories. The Enneagram uses nine. I do not read the horoscope but there are twelve categories

In the scriptures the most famous pairing is Martha and Mary. We probably know persons who are busy and active like Martha as well as others who are reflective and quiet like Mary. Jesus called twelve as apostles and they were very different. Jesus also sent them out two by two increasing the chances their message might be accepted.

Paul uses the example of the human body to describe the community. Surely the human body consists of many quite different parts. All are important for healthy living. The Christian community has many different parts as well. There are different talents, gifts, personalities, ages, sizes, and shape. We are the Body of Christ and each and every member is important for a healthy community life.



# **Request for Papal Blessings**

If you have a special event coming up in your own life or in the life of your family, e.g., wedding, 25<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary, special birthday, you may want to request a Papal Blessing to mark the occasion. The blessings can come from either the Vatican itself or the Vatican Embassy in Washington, D.C.

# Please note the following guidelines:

- 1.) The individuals named in the blessing must be practicing Catholics;
- 2.) Only one blessing can be obtained per person;
- 3.) If requested from the Vatican, the blessing should be requested 4 months in advance of the occasion. The cost is \$45.00.
- 4.) If requested from the Vatican Embassy in Washington, D.C., the blessing should be requested 2 months in advance. The cost is \$30.00.

These requests have to be made through the St. Mary's office. *Please plan ahead if you want to request a Papal Blessing*.


