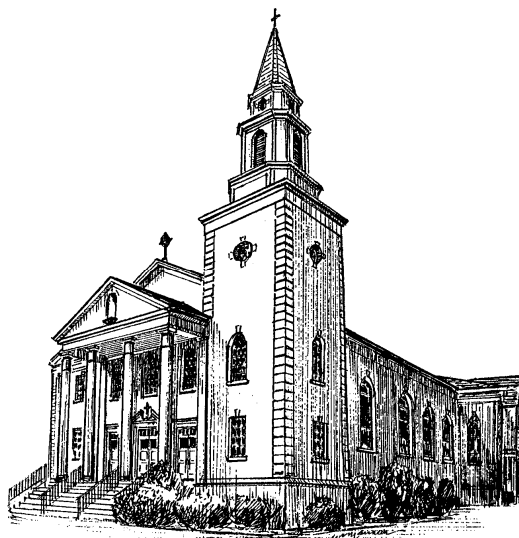

Catechumenate

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process by which adults (and children who have reached the age of reason) are prepared to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. If you, or someone you know, would like to inquire about becoming a Catholic, please call the parish office.

Ministry to the Sick and Homebound

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is available to be celebrated with anyone in need. Please do not wait until death is imminent to contact the parish regarding an ill family member. Eucharistic Ministers and others serve our community by visiting and bringing Communion to the sick and homebound. Please call the parish office if you wish such a visit.

**From the
Pastor**



As we celebrate the great feast of Pentecost this Sunday, we mark the birth of the Holy Catholic Church. The disciples were no longer a fear-filled group of Jewish converts who believed that Jesus of Nazareth was the long awaited Messiah. In the reception of the Holy Spirit, they became the bold heralds of the Good News of Salvation. No longer would they hide behind locked doors. Instead they fill the streets with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. They were commissioned to spread the Word of God to the ends of the earth and the fact that, two thousand years later we celebrate this day, proves they succeeded.

The Gift of the Holy Spirit, received by the Apostles on Pentecost, was also given to you and me in the Waters of Baptism. This means that we too are commissioned to spread the Good News of Salvation. We may not have “the gift of tongues,” but we have received so many other gifts. Our tradition teaches us that the 7 gifts of the Holy Spirit are Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety and Fear of the Lord. These are not just words we might remember from a religion class many years ago. These are gifts given to us so that we might build up the Church whose birth we celebrate today.

The Feast of Pentecost also marks the end of the Easter season. But, if we truly allow the Holy Spirit to guide us, Easter is not a season. It is a way of life. We live as people who are constantly aware of what Jesus has done for us. How in His death and resurrection, we are offered the hope of eternal salvation. We live as a people who have received the gift of the Holy Spirit; a Spirit that is the abiding of presence of Jesus in our world today. We live as people who have been taught to call God our Father; a Father who love for us is beyond measure.
