From the Pastor

Yesterday afternoon, Archbishop Myers ordained 27 men to the Permanent Diaconate for service in the Church of Newark. Last Saturday, he ordained 10 men to the Priesthood and the weekend before, he ordained 6 men to the Transitional Diaconate. These transitional deacons will hopefully be ordained priests next year.

While it is true that our Archdiocese ordains more men than most other diocese, the number of men being ordained is far smaller than the number of those who are retiring. This shortage of priests is starting to have a serious effect throughout our Archdiocese and has led to the closing or merging of several parishes.

While we, as a Church, must confront the challenge of fewer priests, we must also work to promote vocations. Sometimes, simply asking a young man if he's ever considered the priesthood is enough to begin the discernment of a vocation. Many of us know a young man or a not-so-young man who might make a good priest. Go ahead, ask the question.

We must also work to promote the Permanent Diaconate. There are many good men who would make wonderful deacons. At the same time, the Church must seriously consider the role of the deacon and how they can better serve the Church.

But even more than that, we all need to pray for those who have recently been ordained. They are entering ministry at a time when the Church is facing some unique challenges. The potential for becoming discouraged is very real. Let us pray that God will make them strong in their faith and compassionate in their ministry. Under the protection of Mary, may they be faithful minister to God's holy people.
