Eucharistic Adoration - Aug. 5th



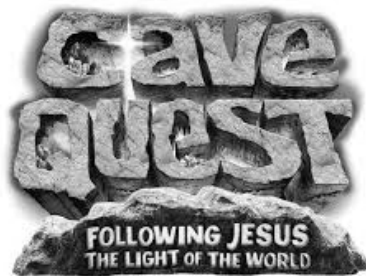
