

Every child in school is taught that the first Thanksgiving Day was a celebration of the Pilgrims of Massachusetts and the Native American people who had helped them secure their first successful harvest in the New World. Thanksgiving Day did not become an official holiday until December 26, 1941 when President Franklin D. Roosevelt signed a joint resolution of Congress declaring the fourth Thursday in November to be a national day of Thanksgiving.

Today, this holiday is a day when families will gather to share a feast. It is also a day for football and for planning holiday shopping that will begin as soon as the meal is finished. Instead of getting caught up in the hype forced upon us by the media, let us remember that the first Thanksgiving Day truly was a day of prayer. A day when we are called to acknowledged how truly blessed we are and a day to share with those who are less fortunate.

One of the many things for which we must give thanks is the naming of a new leader for the Archdiocese of Newark. Last week Pope Francis named Joseph Tobin to succeed our current Archbishop. He will be formally installed on January 6, 2016. Before that however, Archbishop Tobin will be elevated to the College of Cardinals so that when he is installed, he will be Cardinal Archbishop of Newark. As we give thanks for our new Archbishop, please join me in praying for him as he assumes his position as our Shepherd.




