# From the Pastor

Last week, I had the privilege of serving at the Mass of Installation as his Eminence, Joseph Cardinal Tobin became the new Archbishop of Newark. The mass, held at the Cathedral Basilica of Sacred Heart before a standing room only congregation, was filled with more than the expected pomp. The music was truly overwhelming and the entire liturgy was carefully planned to reflect the glory and structure of the Church.

But despite all the efforts to insure that the liturgy was appropriately formal, what struck me most is the humanity the star of the show brought to the proceedings. More than once, Cardinal Tobin went off script upsetting those who thought they had carefully planned every last detail. When the Cardinal was supposed to hand the Papal Mandate to the Chancellor of the Archdiocese so that it could be presented to the College of Consultors, he decided that he would do it himself and then he proceeded to walk the length of the Cathedral as he presented the Mandate to the entire congregation.

Sitting in on the aisle in the front pew was the mother of Cardinal Tobin and his twelve younger brothers and sisters. During his closing remarks, the Cardinal thanked his family for teaching him how to love. He also thanked them for teaching him how to share. As he said, "When you grow up in a house with eight sisters and only one bathroom, you have to learn how to share."

In addition to thanking the family that raised him, as a member of the Redemptorists, Cardinal Tobin thanked the religious community that had formed him as priest. He thanked the people of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis that has been his family for the past four years. Finally, he thanked the people of the Archdiocese of Newark that will be his new family. He asked that we all pray for him as he begins his new ministry shepherding the 1.3 million Catholics that are his new family.

Faced with increasing needs for services and declining resources, Cardinal Tobin will need all our prayers as he strives to serve as our Archbishop. He brings a great deal of talent and experience. Most importantly, he brings hope to an Archdiocese in need. Let us pray for Cardinal Tobin and let us continue to hope.
