Our parish community was blessed on Easter Sunday when five youngsters were initiated into the Catholic Church through the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. It was cause for great celebration for our parish and the entire Catholic Church. As we go through the Easter Season, the celebration will continue as we continue to celebrate the Sacraments of Initiation.

This Sunday at the 12 noon mass, four young adults will complete their initiation as Catholics through the Sacrament of Confirmation. Two of them will also receive First Eucharist. Starting next Sunday and continuing through May 21th, 59 youngsters in our Religious Education program will receive First Eucharist at various masses. On June 4th, Pentecost Sunday, Bishop Flesey will join us for the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation as 72 teens will complete their sacramental initiation as Catholics.
