From the Pastor

Once Mother's Day and First Communions are over, you can be sure that graduation time is here at last. It does not matter if it is grammar school, high school, or college: graduation ceremonies are always called commencement ceremonies because for those who are graduating, it may be the end of one phase of their lives over but a whole new adventure is about to begin.

In my last parish, one of my favorite duties as pastor was to give out the diplomas for the children graduating from kindergarten. 
