The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process by which adults (and children who have reached the age of reason) are prepared to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. 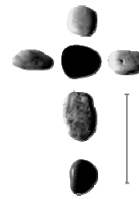
The summer is winding down which means things usually get pretty quiet before the new school year begins. Not here at St. Mary's. August has been a busy month and I need to say thank you to so many people.
